THE HOLY GOSPEL

Response Before: Glory to you, Lord Christ.

At that time, Jesus talked about the children of the Kingdom in the age of the resurrection in this way: he said, "They can no longer die, because they are like angels and are God's children since they share in the resurrection. Even Moses demonstrated that the dead are raised—in the passage about the burning bush, when he speaks of the Lord as the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. He isn't the God of the dead but of the living. To him they are all alive."

Response After: **Praise to you, Lord Christ.**

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. 

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER THE GREAT THANKSGIVING Celebrant: The Lord be with you. People: And also with you. Celebrant: Lift up your hearts. People: We lift them to the Lord. Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Celebrant: It is the joy of our salvation, God of the universe, to give you thanks through Jesus Christ. And now we give you thanks because on the first day of the week he overcame death and the grave, and opened to us the way of everlasting life.

And so, with all your saints, who are as countless as the stars in the sky, we praise you for our creation and our calling as we sing:



THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER CONTINUES

Celebrant: Glory and honor and praise to you, holy and living God.

People: You are the source of all life and goodness.

- Celebrant: Through your eternal Word you created everything that is, and made us in your image. When we sinned and turned away from your love, you called us back to yourself, and gave your Son to be human like we are.
 - People: Born to the Virgin Mary, he came to the rescue of our human race. Dying for us, he trampled death and conquered sin.
- Celebrant: By the glory of his resurrection he opened the way to eternal life and by his ascension, gave us the sure hope that where he is, we will be also.
 - People: On the night before he died for us, our Savior Jesus Christ took bread, and when he had given thanks to you, he broke it, and gave it to his friends, and said:
- Celebrant: "Take, eat: This is my Body which is given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me." ✤ (Pause for the elevation)

People: As supper was ending, **Jesus took the cup of wine, and when he had** given thanks, he gave it to them, and said:

Celebrant: "Drink this, all of you: This is my blood of the new Covenant, which is poured out for you and for all for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of me." ★ (Pause for the elevation)

Therefore we proclaim the mystery of faith:

- All: Christ has died. Christ is risen.Christ will come again.
- Celebrant: Remembering now the suffering and death and proclaiming the resurrection and ascension of Jesus our Redeemer, we bring before you these gifts. Sanctify them by your Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of Christ.
 - All: Send your Holy Spirit upon us also 4, and grant that we who eat this Bread and drink this Cup may be filled with your life and goodness.
- Celebrant: Through Christ and with Christ and in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, to you be honor, glory, and praise, for ever and ever. People: **AMEN!**

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Celebrant: And now, as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to say,

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.


