

Dear Saint Philip's Artist,

March 1, 2025

Thank you for participating in the All Saint Philip's Art Show in the Murphey Gallery. You should have your original new work at the West Gallery between 9:00am-10:00am, Friday, April 4 or on by 8:30 am on Saturday, April 5. You are not responsible for hanging; the Gallery Committee will do that when we have all the artwork. It is imperative that you deliver your work promptly. The exhibit will run through to Friday, May 2, 2025. Work is to be picked up at 9:00 am on Friday, May 2. There is a 20% commission payable to Saint Philips for all work sold, payable at the end of the Show.

Please note that we have a professional hanging system in the Gallery. WOODEN FRAMES ARE PREFERRED. This is because our hanging system uses two small temporary fixtures screwed (to a depth of approx. 1/8 inch or 3 mm) into the back of each frame. This allows the picture to slide up and down on movable wires for optimal placement. The Murphey Gallery volunteers insert the screws and remove them at the end of the show. Our system reduces the possibility of theft and once the art is properly installed it will not fall or need straightening.

We do have some hook fixtures to use with metal and plastic frames, but these frames should have wires placed on the back to accommodate the hook system. The hook system allows the pictures to be easily removed and tilted, hence the preference for wooden frames.

You should have with you when you deliver your work, labels on white cardstock in the following format (2 1/2" x 3 1/2"):

Your name  
Title of work  
Medium  
Your phone number  
Price (if not for sale, please use NFS)

We will accept 2 works from 16" x 20" or larger, or 4 smaller works per person. All work to be exhibited should be framed with picture wire except fiber art. Please contact us about hanging rugs, quilts, tapestry or similar work. Only wall hung art can be accepted.

There will be an **All Saint Philip's Reception** on Sunday, April 6 immediately after the 10 am service. We hope you will be there to share your art with your fellow Parishioners.
